# 1. About Gyan Jyot Project



## EDUCATION PROJECTS

### INTRODUCTION :

APM Terminals, a multinational company operating at Pipavav Port, launched special program under its CSR Initiative named GYAN JYOT in two blocks of Amreli district. The project is implemented by Swadeep. The project aims to improve the quality of education in 7 villages of these 2 blocks, for which activities being carried out with Anganwadis, Primary Schools, Secondary Schools and villagers as well. Under Gyan Jyot Project Swadeep has been working with 15 Anganwadis, 9 Primary Schools and 3 School High Schools for quality education and moreover Adult literacy class, open school initiative for drop out children, awareness programs with parents and community regarding education and health also organised.

### PROJECT COVERAGE :

Gyan Jyot Project is implemented in 7 Villages of Rajula and Jafrabad Blocks of Amreli district. Six Villages of Rajula namely; Kadiyali, Rampara, Bherai, Devpara, Kumbhariya and Pipavav while one village of Jafrabad Block named- Shiyalbet. This involves 15 ICDS Centers, 9 Primary Schools and 3 High Schools.

## ACTIVITIES OF GYAN JYOT PROJECT

Under the Gyan Jyot project, Anganwadi to High School as well as public awareness activities are carried out to improve the quality of education and improve the living standards of the people. To ensure the long term objective of the project is addressed, following activities carried out during the year;

### A PARENTS MEETING

Parents play the most important role in children's life, therefore to involve them and aware about importance of education in children's life parents meetings are organized with ICDS and School Children's parents. During the year 2 rounds of parents meeting was organized which covered 1687 parents from 7 villages.



### B COMMUNITY EDUCATION AWARENESS (STREET PLAY):

With objective to address problems such as lack of education awareness, Cleanliness, Health and Hygiene, Superstitions etc. an awareness program is organised at village level. 8 street plays were organized respectively in 8 villages of project area, which was witnessed by total 4580 people.



### C CLEANLINESS CORNER :

Cleanliness and hygiene is as important and necessary for good health as educational activity is. And to implement the same in educational institutions of project area, we distribute Cleanliness/Hygiene kits and put emphasis upon using it to attain hygiene level in Anganwadis and Schools.



## **D GARBH SANSKARAN :**

Garbh Sanskaran training is being organized with pregnant women or newly married women of villages. The main purpose of this training is to get familiar with the 16 sacraments of Hindu religion and learn the importance of Garbh Sanskaran.<sup>2</sup> Garbh Sanskaran trainings were organized in which 96 Women from 7 villages covered.



## **E PARVARISH :**

Under Gyan Jyot Project 4-day residential program is organised for girls. The main focus is on personality development and provides value base education to girls by building self-confidence among them. *Parvarish Camp was organised for 4 days at Baal Krishna Vidhyalaya-Rajula where 180 girls from 6 villages total participated.*





## **F CAPACITY BUILDING (EXPOSURE) :**

An exposure tour was organised for Anganwadi workers and Adult literacy teachers for 2 days. The main purpose of exposure visit was for Anganwadi workers to see what kind of educational activities are done with children from 3 to 6 years of age at Baal Chetanwadi- the institution which is working on pre-primary education. *Total 24 women participated in 2 days exposure program.*

## **G PARVARISH FOR WOMEN :**

Women have a lot of responsibility of household and they are the support system of any house that takes care of family. Thus it is important for women to develop positive outlook towards life and nurture the family as well. With such objective a full day Parvarish Program is organized at block level where different topics are discussed with women to develop new perspective in their life.

## **H ENROLLMENT DRIVE :**

In this initiative we make sure every child in the village, which is at the age of going to ICDS or School or High school must be enrolled in ICDS/ School/ High School. Also we re-enrol the dropout students to the schools and make sure they continue with their study. In addition to it an enrollment kit is distributed to each and every child who is enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> STD to encourage them.

## **I PRE-PRIMARY CHILDREN :**

Pre-primary education is of utmost importance and basic education. Pre-primary education plays important role as Children's motor skills are developed during this stage as well as language development and thinking ability and their ability to distinguish also develops.



With a purpose of improving quality of pre-primary education different activities are done with children, Anganwadi workers, Helpers and Parents Awareness work is also done. *Total 483 Pre-primary children are covered in Anganwadi activities from 15 ICDS Centers.*

## **J** **ACTIVITY BASE LEARNING IN SCHOOLS :**

Activity base learning initiative has been started with schools in which various activities are done with children and methods used are more focused on the activity based learning methods which includes;

- Learning Resource Center activities- Total 12 LRC Class was running under Gyan Jyot Project in 9 Schools and 353 students were enrolled in these classes.
- Summer Camp: Summer camps were organized for children to learn and develop new skills during vacation time, students voluntarily came and participated different learning activities as per their interest.
- Special Days Celebration: Important days are celebrated with the children in school, so that the children know the importance of these special days.
- Career Counseling Program for 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standard children
- Library – Book reading activity is done with children to develop reading habit among them. Under this initiative 16,869 books read by Children in 12 schools.
- Baal Mela/SarjanMela/Mojhilu Shikshan: To provide children knowledge with fun, improve their thinking ability and creativity, best from waste materials





## **K OPEN SCHOOL :**

Young children of village are explained the concept of Open Schooling- Baba SahebAmbedkar Open University, Course offered there, its benefit, the admission process etc. and interested student's admission are done under BPP course in Baba SahebAmbedkar Open University. So far a total of 45 students had taken admission under Open University initiative.

## **L SPORTS DAY CELEBRATION :**

Sports can be considered an important part of a child's development as one does not learn as much as he/she learns from sports. Integrated Sports Day is organized under Gyan Jyot Project in which students from 12 Primary and High Schools of Rajula taluka participates every year.



## **M ADULT LITERACY CLASS :**

Knowledge of numbers and letters in everyday life are very essential and useful. Thus, the Adult Literacy Classes are running in 7 villages of Rajula area for the purpose of making the women of the age group of 18 to 60 years literate so they can at least read or write the basic letters/numbers etc. 167 women covered under Adult Literacy Class.



## 2. About Vidhya Jyot Project

### A. SUTRAPADA



#### INTRODUCTION :

With financial support of GHCL Foundation, Swadeep has made an attempt to strengthen the foundation of the children by implementing field based program named 'Vidhya Jyot Project'. Vidhya Jyot Project Works at all the three stages of the Education systems. It begins with the children at the Anganwadis, and thereafter with the children attending the Primary Schools and goes up to the High Schools children. The Project covers 62 ICDS Centers, 12 Primary Schools and 4 High-School from 21 villages of Veraval, Talala and Sutrapada Talukas of Gir-Somnath District.

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW :

The educational initiative is targeted to different age group children. This includes the toddlers, the primary school children and the Secondary school children. Under the project a separate set of activities is planned and executed.

## ACTIVITIES WITH ANGANWADI :

The Vidhya Jyot Project approach is to create a simple, beautiful and an effective atmosphere for preschool education for the toddlers in collaboration with the local community. Children of 60 Anganwadis Participate in Nandghar Program's various activity which includes Cards activity, BalGeet, Drawing, Small home activity like find out various beans and nuts, prepare chapatti, cultural activity etc.

### **A PARENTS MEETING:**

Parents are the pioneer stone of Child development, without them we can't imaging the future of child. In Vidhya Jyot Project, we focus on regular parents meeting held in Anganwadi, and our agendas are based on children's educational and social development.

### **B BAAL OLYMPIC ACTIVITY :**

A new initiative was started to improve Parents Participation in Anganwadi with their children. Children's Olympics Program recognizes the importance of sports to the public, as well as the relationships with children, guardians, and helper-workers. 60 programs was organised in which total 1523 parents participated.



### **ANGANWADI WORKERS & HELPERS TRAINING:**

Anganwadi Workers training cum workshop are organised on monthly basis where they are trained on different topics, activities which can be used to improvise the activities at Anganwadi centers. Some of Agendas for AWW training are- Effective Child Development, Creativity art and Craft, Baal git and Abhinay Git, Puppet making etc. Anganwadi Helpers sister plays an important role in Anganwadi as well, therefore for capacity building of helper sisters training were organised quarterly.





## **D EXPOSURE:**

Exposure is the important tool for learning. It gives lots of energy for learning new things and exploring new ideas to improve our regular activities. GHCL Foundation and SWADEEP organized exposure for key stakeholders of the project, which are Anganwadi workers, Helpers and Parents of ICDS toddlers. 4 exposures were organized during the year and places were Children's University-Gandhinagar, Shreyas Foundation-A'bad, Environmental Sanitation Institute, Dakshina murti, Lok Bharti Sanosara, IIM Ahmedabad etc. Total 192 people took part in exposure.



## **ACTIVITIES WITH PRIMARY SCHOOLS :**

### **A ENROLMENT CEREMONY:**

The Enrolment ceremony aimed at ensuring a hundred per cent enrolment in primary schools; with the remarkable effort of GHCL foundation and SWADEEP 100% Children enrolment in Primary School from our targeted Anganwadi Centers of Sutrapada, Veraval block. The KanyaKelavani Abhiyan spells out our determination to give an impetus to educating the girl child. 692 students who got enrolled in standard 1<sup>st</sup> were provided an Enrolment kit for encouragement.

## **B PARENTS' MEETING (SCHOOL) :**

Parents Meeting should be used as a platform to make a lasting bond with the parent to increase the likelihood of academic success for their child. In Vidhya Jyot project parent's meeting is used as platform to communicate the children's areas of excellence and how to improve upon their child's performance.

## **C SCHOOL OLYMPIAD :**



Sports play a vital role for Children Development in physical, Psychological and Social Development. Different games were held in school Olympiad program. This brings out the subtle powers that are in the children and children and their guardians know about their child's interest, which can have a good impact on the future of the child.



## **D PRIMARY SCHOOL KIT DISTRIBUTION :**

Today's school-going children are going to be future Leaders of our country. To Support children in competitive exam like NMMS, Navoday examination GHCL foundation provide exam preparation material to each participant student. Total 280 Student benefited with this kit.

## **ACTIVITIES WITH HIGH SCHOOLS :**

Secondary high school education serves as a link between the elementary and higher education, and plays a very important role in helping children to choose a vocation and make a living out of it. Child's future depends a lot on the type of education she/he receives at the Secondary level. To guide children for their bright future and help them with academics Vidhya Jyot project carry out following activities with High School.



## **A LEARNING CLASS :**

SWADEEP and GHCL Foundation provide an extra tutor for Math's and English Subject in 5 high schools. A total of 498 students studying at the Secondary and higher Secondary in these 4 schools benefitted out of this support.

## **B CAREER GUIDANCE :**

10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard are very crucial for children as well as Parents, regarding career of children. Under Vidhya Jyot Project to overcome this concern a Career counselling program was organised with the children and their parents.



## **C PARIKSHA MAHOTSAV :**

Impact of Board Exam creates very severe condition on 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard student. With this condition student faces many difficulty in preparation to give exam. Therefore 'ParikshaMahotsav' was organised in 4 high schools of project area for 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard children to cope up with their exam fear. Total 498 Students Participate in 'Exam Mahotsav' and approx. 6 Paper of each subject was written.



## 2. About Vidhya Jyot Project

### B. VICTOR



### INTRODUCTION :

After successfully implementing 'Vidhya Jyot Project' at Sutrapada, GHCL Foundation decided to spread this project over Rajula Taluka where with 24 ICDS from 11 villages of Rajula and Jafrabad Taluka same intervention with ICDS was started which is also called Vidhya Jyot Project. The project aims to strengthen system of Pre-primary education through Capacity Building of Stakeholders and Service provider. It makes effort to make education more joyful for the Pre-Primary School children by introducing a multi-level learning support program. It also helps to create resource materials to fill up the learning deficits of children and bring them to their age-appropriate learning levels.

### ABOUT PROJECT AREA :

Vidhya Jyot project is currently implemented in 25 ICDS Centers of Rajula and Jafrabad block of Amreli district, Gujarat. This covers 19 ICDS centers of Rajula block and 06 ICDS Center of Jafrabad block, Rajula.

## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :



### **A ANGANWADI VISIT & ACTIVITY WITH CHILDREN :**

Anganwadi visits and activities with the children occur on the regular basis. The general perspective of it is to increase children's participation in activities and to work for children's overall development along with Anganwadi. Children are learners rather than the passive receiver, of information. To begin with, activity-based learning with simple tools like Action songs, storytelling, children's songs, three-dimensional models, experiments, puzzles, sand work, flash cards, role play methods, and so on are used with ICDS toddlers.



## **B PARENTS' MEETING :**

Development of a child begins within the family and mostly depends on the parents. That's why under Vidhya Jyot Project special focus is given on parent's awareness and community participation, it is an important element in the design of ICDS. The parent's awareness meetings were held twice in a year per Anganwadi centre. During these meetings topics involved about the importance of Anganwadi centres and its regularity for the children's overall growth, parent's participation in the children's daily routine, etc.



## **C ANGANWADI WORKERS CAPACITY BUILDING MEETINGS/ TRAININGS :**

With the fruitful approach of GHCL Foundation Trust under Vidhya Jyot Project, Anganwadi Workers Meetings are organised on monthly basis for the capacity building of AWWs. The discussion and the activities are about various topics related to Anganwadi functioning and Early Childhood Education. There used to be different resource person to facilitate these training and make it more meaningful and enjoyable.

## **D ANGANWADI HELPERS MEETINGS/ TRAININGS :**

The Anganwadi helper's capacity building trainings were organized on quarterly basis. The agendas discussed in this training were about the cleanliness, to make the children self-dependent, and about the importance of creative activities for the children. The helpers too play major part in the implementation of the project. They are having their unique role to keep the centre clean and nit, to cook food in healthy and hygienic condition, to bring and drop the children from their houses, etc.





## **E ANGANWADI WORKERS EXPOSURE :**



It is a known fact that seminar room education is restricted with the course in a monotonous manner. However, educational exposure could provide one with an opportunity to come in direct contact with several different instructors who can impart a variety of learning experiences as well as knowledge into them. Hence, Educational Exposer was organised for the capacity building of Anganwadi workers. In which, CDPO and Supervisors from Jafrabad district were also involved. Exposer visit was held at Dakshinamurti, Bhavnagar and LokBharti, Sanosara, and other sight visits.

## **F MATERIAL DISTRIBUTIONS :**

Through educational branding, the Anganwadi centres are transformed in a way which can be comfortable and pleasant for the Anganwadi workers and the children. The play materials, TLMs, Story Charts are distributed to Anganwadis for the children; Distribution of the basic requirements of the centre (a Closet, Fan, First Aid Kit, Mats); Cleanliness Kit; Workbooks, Crayons, Colour, Picture Books Distribution etc.



# 3. Shiksha Sarthi



## EDUCATION PROJECTS

### INTRODUCTION :

Education Program mainly focuses on the Primary Education as primary education forms the basic foundation for a life time growth and learning. The Project lays special emphasis on developing learning abilities of children especially for subjects like English, and Mathematics. With 3 to 5 standard children regular classes of English Improvement and Maths extra coaching, while with 6 to 8 standard children Computer Literacy Program are the main focus. Other than this Development Camp for 6 to 8 Standard children, Aid for various TLMs, Work-Book, and Note-Books are provided too.

### PROJECT AREA :

The project is implemented in 5 Primary Schools of respective villages of Patdi and Anjar block, Surendranagar and Kutch district. Dhama and Fatepur village from patdi block, Surendranagar and 3 sub village of Khirsara from anjar block, Kutch district.



## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :

### **A** COMPUTER LITERACY :

As technology continues to advance, computer has become a part of everyday life. Computer literacy, involves having a current knowledge and understanding of computer and their uses. With financial support of WREL (TATA Power), we are running computer literacy program for 6 to 8 standard children in 5 schools of project area. Computer literacy program provides computer education to these children with special focus on practical as well. Total 265 children covered in Computer Literacy Initiative.



### **B** ENGLISH IMPROVEMENT :

At present, English is one of the major languages used for communication in the world. Language is nothing but a systematic means of communication by the use of words, symbols and sounds. And English is one of the most widely spoken languages. For English improvement regular classes for 6 to 8 standard children in 5 schools of project area are running where children are taught English. Total 270 children are taking English Improvement classes under this initiative.





## **D LEARNING CAMPS:**

Learning Camps are organised in the schools for 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standard students. It mainly focuses on the learning experience of children through practical knowledge. In learning camp we focus on practical learning for practical subject such as Science. During the project period we have organised 2 rounds of Science Practical for each school. In this one day program a team of resource persons teach students of 6, 7 and 8 standard science experiments practically and also students will perform the same on their own.



## **E EXTRA COACHING CLASS FOR MATHS:**

In extra coaching class for Mathematics we work with 3 to 5 standard students of 5 schools. Some of these children are weak in Mathematics subject. In extra coaching class we provide these students special attention to minimise their learning deficit for Math subject. Under this activity a teacher takes regular classes in school for math with 3 to 5 standard. Special TLMs and activities are done with children to teach math subject. This will enhance their learning abilities for the subject which is main objective behind this initiative. Total 280 children are covered in this Activity.



## **F EXTRA COACHING CLASS FOR GUJARATI :**

Extra coaching class for Gujarati subject was started especially for 3 schools of Khirsara village. Among these 3 villages, 2 villages have 100% Muslim community and their mother tongue is 'kachchi'. Because of this, children of these 2 villages have lack of understanding for Gujarati language. To remove this learning deficit for Gujarati we decided to start extra coaching classes for Gujarati subject in these 3 schools. Workbook specially designed for children with learning deficit, is provided to these children as well. 95 students from 3 school were covered in this initiative.



## **G STAKEHOLDER'S SANSITIZATION :**

Low level of Education is common problem of village community. They are not aware of importance of education. This intervention we focussed on building community awareness and sensitization towards the school, leading to better transparency, accountability and management of schools. Towards this end, Parents Meeting, Vali Sampark activity was done regularly.

## **H HEALTH CAMP :**

During the year 2 health camps were organised by collaboration with local PHC/ Other Institutions. During last year with financial support of WREL Health Program was implemented and total 10 health camps were organised in the project area which received very positive responses. And that's why this year too with collaborative efforts of organisation one Health Camp at each site was organised which benefited total 305 people from these villages.



## NIOS EXTRA COACHING CLASS PROGRAM :

With financial support of WREL-TPCDT, Swadeep has started a Study centre for NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling) to decrease the dropout rate at Fatepur village. Dropout ratio was surprisingly very high after standard 8 in these 5 villages. With counselling and lot of efforts we identified potential students who were willing to study through NIOS. 9 children were admitted to NIOS Secondary Course and one special coaching class was set up in Fatepur village for these children. Through this special coaching center we provide them coaching for 5 subjects which are selected for NIOS secondary course examination. After passing this examination these children will get certificate which is equivalent to std-10 board examination.





# 4. Learning & Migration Project (LAMP)



## EDUCATION PROJECTS

### INTRODUCTION :

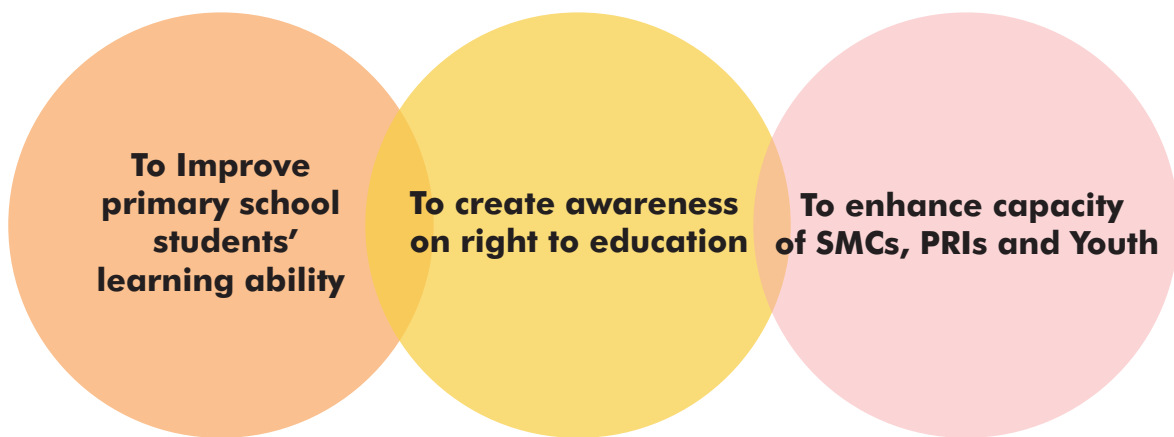
The Learning and Migration Program (LAMP) focuses on basic education support, particularly in the areas of Maths and language, and structures learning through group work, games, art and variety of other teaching learning support materials to bring students to age appropriate learning levels. In addition to working with students, LAMP also works with communities and school management committees to raise awareness about Right to Education Act. The School Management Committees work to foster trust between village leaders, parents and families to establish the importance of education for the children. Besides, SMC Federation trained by Swadep is actively working in 50 villages of Mahuva Block for school development and strengthening of SMC.

### PROJECT OVERVIEW :

Program provides safe structured and nurturing environment to attend schools. There are two components of the LAMP program: student support and community-based advocacy which leads to fulfill following objectives of program;



## PROJECT AREA :

Project was implemented in 10 villages of Mahuva block, Bhavnagar district of Gujarat.

## ACTIVITIES OF LAMP :

### **A** MIGRATION :

LAMP addresses the very serious issue of migration and its adverse effects on children who belong to such family. No of children at risk of migration is identified through Migration survey. After that we facilitate SMC/PRI members to file an application for seasonal hostel in respective villages for these children or meanwhile we try to retain some of these children by doing counseling of their parents and convince them to keep children with family members in village who will look after them.

During the year total 167 children were identified at risk of Migration from 6 villages out of which 110 children were retained through efforts of SMC, PRI, CE and LRC facilitator. Those children who we couldn't retain through caregivers, we make sure they have taken migration certificate with them and advised their parents to continue their children's study there too.

### **B** LEARNING ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (LEP) :



LEP is designed to address the learning needs of first generation learners. This is meant for children who have been promoted to grades III-V but who still have basic learning deficits of Language and Math (of grade level I-II) they are unable to read and write and deal with numbers and number operations. During the year, 2 LEP classes in 2 villages through identifying the deficit children with baseline papers of the children studying in class III to V. on the basis of the finding of the baseline papers 70 children have been selected for 2 LEP classes.

## **◆ LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE (LRC) :**

Swadeep has been successfully running 2 LRC (Learning Resource Centre) covering 8 other nearby Spook villages. LRC has provided academic support and information for older students, has resulted in improving the learning deficits of the students of different grade and also improving teaching practices in schools covered by Learning Resource Centre.

Total 141 Children are covered in LEP and LRC class while 298 children covered through 8 LRC spoke schools to improve their language comprehension.



## **◆ BAAL-MELA :**

During the year, one round of Bal-mela has been organized at school. A total of 923 children were engaged in various learning activities facilitated during Bal-mela. The children, school teachers and youth members together celebrated a day with lots of extra curriculum activities which promotes Activity base learning. Children really enjoyed it.





## **E VILLAGE LEVEL COMMUNITY CONSULTATION :**

Significant improvement in the educational scenario is not possible without the active involvement of all key stakeholders and SMC/PRI, children, parents, communities, local self-government bodies, teachers, education functionaries- all need to be involved in proactive partnerships. There for village level community consultation is done in 2 rounds of meeting. The focus of the consultations had been to discuss the issues which are affecting in strengthening the level of primary education at the village level.



## **F SMC, PRIs & CE TRAINING CUM MEETING :**

The objective of the training was to sensitize and strengthen the SMCs and the PRIs members on the roles and responsibilities of SMC and PRI under 'Right to Education Act' and enable them to address issues of their school and improve the status of primary education in their respective villages. Two clusters were covered through the issued-based training for SMCs, PRIs and CE members.

## **F FEDERATION MEETING :**

Regular meeting of federation members of Mahuva block were organized on school based issues. Meetings were conducted with the federation members on different aspects of inclusive education. Focus was also given on strengthening the SMCs and helping them to understand their roles and responsibilities. SMC federation is working very effectively in the area and actively takes part in all school matters and tries to resolve issues as well.

# 5. Gyan Deep



## EDUCATION PROJECTS

### INTRODUCTION :

Pipavav Railway Corporation Ltd. (PRCL) is the 50:50 Joint Venture Company of Indian Railways and the Gujarat Pipavav Port Ltd (GPPL) and company being highly involved in Social Responsibility launched 'Gyan Deep Program' in 5 villages of Rajula block. Gyan Deep Project is adaption of Gyan Jyot Project itself covering other 5 villages of the same block with same activities. Gyan Deep Project has been designed with aim to eradicate poverty by enhancing the education level and behavioural change among the community members. The project is implemented in Rajula Taluka in Amreli district. Project carried out certain outcome oriented initiatives for improvement of the education scenario of the area.

**Supporting Partner:** Pipavav Railway Corporation (PRCL)

**Project Area:** Rajula, District-Amreli

### PROJECT AREA :

Gyandeep initiative covers Ningala, Chatadiya, Vad, Uchaiya and Bhachadar villages of Rajula taluka. Total 240 ICDS Children, 368 Primary School Children, and 2171 population of these 5 villages are covered under the project.



## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :

### **A PARENTS MEETING :**

Parents meeting with the guardians of Anganwadi and school children was organized under the Gyanadeep project. In this meeting, parents were given information on different topics for hygiene, health and education awareness. During this year, a total of 15 meetings were organized at primary schools and Anganwadi in which 449 parents participated.



### **B COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROGRAM (STREET PLAY) :**

Street plays are wonderful platform to connect with the people. A street Play was organized in collaboration with the PRCL and Swadeep organization to create awareness in the society. The main purpose of these street plays was to deliver social awareness regarding issues like girl child education, child labor, migration of locals etc. to the village community. Total 1988 people from these 5 villages witnessed this Street-play program.



## **DE-ADDICTION, HEALTH & SAFETY AWARENESS (SCHOOL):**

Same way Street-Play Programs were organised at school level to aware children about harmful effects of Addiction, health and safety etc. With same awareness theme a drama was performed in Schools which children enjoyed a lot. Total 550 children at schools witnessed drama.



## **CLEANLINESS CORNER :**

ICDS-School hygiene and sanitation are especially important because children spend great deal of time at school-ICDS and they need a healthy environment to learn and grow, physically, mentally and socially. To promote cleanliness at ICDS and Schools, the Cleanliness kit is distributed under project.

## **GARBH SANSKARAN SHOP :**

Under the 'Gyandeeep' project, the Gharbh Sanskar workshop was organized. In this training, the actual meaning of embryo was explained to the sisters. The experts imparted knowledge. Thus, sisters have come to know the true meaning of the fetus and they have developed an understanding of how to take care during pregnancy and how to maintain the environment of the house and by the family members. 125 women participated in these workshops.



## **PARVARISH CAMP FOR SCHOOL:**

Under the Gyandeeep project, a four-day Parvarish camp was organized for the children at Lok Bharati Sanosara. The main focus is on personality development and provides value base education to children and building self-confidence among them. Camp was organized in two batches with total 141 children.



## **WOMAN PARVARISH CAMP :**

Under Gyandeeep Project, Parvarish camps were organised for women of the village as well. The main aim was to bring awareness to the educational, economic, health and children among women of local community. During this program the social responsibility of women was appreciated. And guidance was given on how to fulfill this responsibility with greater quality. Parvarish Camp were organised at block level and village level separately which covered total 320 women from 5 villages.





## ❖ CAPACITY BUILDING OF ANGANWADI WORKER, HELPER:

The Anganwadi Worker training is held every month in which different topic regarding ECE is discussed, reviews and planning of activities with children is also done. Moreover for capacity building of AWW, an educational exposure visit was organized along with 5 villages of Anganwadi workers. The purpose of this exposure visit was to learn new experiments related to pre-primary education of children and to implement same in their own Anganwadi.

## ❖ BAAL-MELA:

'Baal Mela' is a great learning experience for children as it increase interests, curiosity and understanding among children for different subjects. It also provides opportunities for teachers and children to exchange ideas, to arouse the interest of the public in the abilities of students and teachers as well as to provide science education for the community. Baal Mela was arranged in different sections like the science, games, books and arts-crafts which all the children enjoyed a lot.



## **K LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE :**

LRC program is mainly focus on weak students. In order to identified the weak students we have developed a question paper on the base of second standard of Gujarati medium. After selected the students on base of Base Line Exams, we have started to conduct their classes on regular base. In this LRC classes we have focus on deficits students from standard 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> . We cover two subject in this classes which are Math and Gujarati.



## **L ADULT LITERACY CLASS:**

Under Gyandeeep project adult literacy classes are running in which the women of the village are given the knowledge of basic literacy like- letters, words, numbers etc. The purpose of this class is to educate the women of these villages with basic literacy so at least they can write, read and calculate the numbers. Total 65 women from 5 villages attended Adult Literacy Class under Gyandeeep Project.





## **M LIBRARY :**

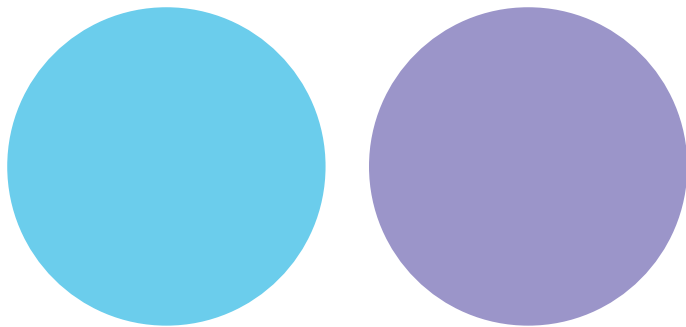
Books play a very important role in everyone's life, especially in a student's life. We learn a lot of things from them. Books are our best companies as they provide us unconditional knowledge without asking anything in return. Therefore to develop habit of reading among children books for library are provided at five primary schools. Main objective is to promote and encourage the reading habits in students.



## **N OTHER AID FOR SCHOOLS:**

- Non-woven bags were distributed in schools with the message of environmental protection and the ban of single use of plastic.
- Litter boxes and trolleys were distributed in schools for green waste and dry waste distribution awareness with the purpose of separately disposing of them for cleanliness in the school.
- Distribution of water tanks, lunch boxes, carpets, identity cards at in schools.
- Assignments for different subject were distributed according to students standard and educational syllabus, so that they would be helpful in their examination for the children studying in the school.

# 1. About Sagar Mitra Project



### INTRODUCTION :

Sagar Mitra project has been initiated by APM Terminals, Pipavav Port at Shiyalbet which is implemented by Swadeep Shikshan Vikas Sanstha. The main objective of the project is to ensure holistic development of livelihood option for the Shiyalbet Bandar of Jafrabad Taluka in Amreli, especially that of the fishermen. To fulfil this objective it was important to create an organization of the fisher folks and implement with them a skill enhancement programme centred on their current livelihood system and thus increase the opportunities for the same.

**Supporting Partner:** APM Terminals, Pipavav Port, Gujarat

**Project Area:** Village- Shiyalbet, Ta-Jafrabad, District-Amreli, Gujarat

### OBJECTIVE :

- Provide information about things that should be taken care of while going for fishing or while fishing.
- Provide information on the maintenance of dry fish and fresh fish.
- Provide information about various governmental schemes and policies for Fishermen and help them in the procedure of filling forms, documentation etc.
- Take fishermen on exposure tour to improve their business and improve economic conditions.
- Facilitate fishermen and distribute the tools which are useful in fishing, also to provide information on how to use those tools.
- Distribute solar boat lights, giving information about its usefulness and benefits.

## PROJECT AREA :

Project is being implemented in Shiyalbet village of Jafrabad Taluka, Dist. Amreli. The village is surrounded by Arabian Sea on all its sides. It is reachable only by Boat from Pipavav Port. Shiyalbet has a total population of 5,096 peoples. There are 832 houses in the village (Census 2011).

## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :

### **A FIC (FISHERIES INFORMATION CENTRE) :**

Fisheries Information Center provides the information about different kind of Government Schemes related to the fishermen, where fishermen can easily access the information, knowledge, training and market linkage with the department of fisheries. It also helps in license applying or renewal and provides the information about how to use different fishing tools and so on. This FIC has various charts which contains lots of information related to fishing business.

During the year 2019-2020 under Sagar Mitra project, a total of **311** fishermen visited the fisheries information center. Apart from this, various services were provided to fishermen such as election card for 4 fishermen, 5 fishermen have opened their bank account, 6 Pagadiya fishermen has received license and 2 fishermen has become eligible to receive the benefits from government schemes.





## **B TRAINING & CAPACITY BUILDING OF FISHERMEN :**

- Training-cum-workshop on '**Fish and Shrimp Disease, its Identification, Signs and its Care**' was organised by Swadeep under Sagar Mitra initiatives. The main purpose of the training was to inform the fishermen and their family members about the diseases in the fish and the steps needed to prevent it.
- Training for '**drying and preserving fish**' was conducted for fishermen. The fishermen were given information on how to dry fish properly as Good drying of fish can provide the fishermen with a good price in the market. Information about packing of dry fish through vacuum packing, which can last longer and maintain good fish prices, was also informed.
- Another capacity enhancement training for '**Pagadiya's fishermen** was organized where fish-related dishes, pickles and other eatable products made by fish' was explained to them to improve the livelihoods, living standards and fishermen's income and fishery production of the fishermen. During this training, fishermen were provided information on how to increase livelihoods by making different dishes from fish. The fishermen were informed about the various schemes and benefits of schemes by the government.



## **DISTRIBUTION OF ICE BOX, TARPAULIN & HAND GLOVES :**

Under the Sagar Mitra Project, ice boxes, tarpaulin & hand gloves were distributed to the fishermen. The ice box is very important to prevent the quality of fish. Tarpaulin is very useful for the drying of fishes. Usually fishermen are drying fish across the sand. As it becomes a waste, its market value decreases. Hand gloves were also distributed to protect the fishermen from cuts. Fishermen were also explained the benefits of using these tools while fishing. Total 79 fishermen have received these benefits.



## **SOLAR BOAT LIGHT DISTRIBUTION :**

Under the Sagar Mitra Project, solar boat light was distributed to the fishermen. Fishermen live with their boats for several days at sea. During the night, the light coming from the solar lights helps greatly. With the help of solar lights, they can also charge their mobile. Fishermen were also explained how to use it and its benefits as well. Solar light has been given to a total of 79 fishermen.



## **E EXPOSURE VISIT :**

An exposure visit to Veraval Fisheries Collage was organized for fishermen under Sagar Mitra Project. The main purpose of this exposure visit was to increase the livelihood of fishermen. The CIFT Research Center provided information on making fish burgers, making shrimps skin powder (which can be used to heal wounds quickly), use of fish oil as medicine and cage fishing. Subsequently, various fish dishes such as pickles, food packets, laundry powder, cosmetics and use of vacuum plastics for packing were taught too. A total of 29 fishermen participated in this exposure visit.



## **F TRAINING ON DRY FISH PACKAGING & SELLING FOR PAGADIYA :**

Training on dry fish packing and sells was organized in Divlo village. During this training, Vacuum packing and simple packing have been explained by systematically. Pagadiya fishermen were informed about the methods of drying fish. Total 26 people participated in this training.

## **G KIT DISTRIBUTION FOR PAGADIYA FISHERMEN:**

Pagadiya fishermen are fishing on the coast. Under the Sagar Mitra Project, they were provided a fishing kit which includes small ice boxes, fish nets, hand gloves, tarpaulin and gumboots etc. Uses and benefit of same was explained to fishermen.

## **G SOLAR LIGHT DISTRIBUTION FOR PAGADIYA FISHERMEN:**

For the past several years, the fishermen have been living and practicing fishery in the seaside area of the villages of Thavi & Divlo. People here are deprived of the basic necessities of life. There is also no primary facility like light and water. Therefore under Sagar Mitra Initiative the solar lights were distributed for their home. The solar home lights are provided to 35 Pagadiya families at Thavi and Divlo villages.



## 2. About Sagar Bandhu Project



### INTRODUCTION :

A subsidiary of Tata Power Company, Coastal Gujarat Private Limited (CGPL), has their 4000MW Ultra Mega Power Plant in Kutch and the company, being highly involved in Corporate Social Responsibility, launched a community-based sustainable livelihood programme in 2013. This initiative, called Sagarbandhu. The Project was focused in the villages of Tragadi and Modhava in Mandvi Taluka which are the major areas where the fisher folk come for fishing and return to when the fishing season ends, and do their alternative jobs, which are highly seasonal.

Supporting Partner: **CGPL**

Project Area: **Tragadi Bandar, Mundra, Kutch**

### PROJECT AREA :

Tragadi Bandar is situated at 6 km toward sea ward side from Tragadi village which is come under Mandvi block. There are about 100 fishermen households who come from different villages and stay about at least 8 to 9 month (August to April) with their family for fishing activity.

## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :



### **A FISHERIES INFORMATION CENTRE:**

Fisheries Information Center provides the information about different kind of Government Schemes related to the fishermen, where fishermen can easily access the information, knowledge, training and market linkage with the department of fisheries. It also helps in license applying or renewal process and provides the information about different fishing tools which can be useful for fishing.





## **B DRINKING WATER :**

The family members of the fishermen living in the port of Tragadi had a lot of water problems. In order to take the attention of community's need for clean drinking water at Tragadi Bundar, We provide 15,000 liters of clean water every day.

## **C TRAINING & CAPACITY BUILDING ON MICROFINANCE :**

Under the CGPL "Sagarbandhu" program, various training is provided for the capacity building of fishermen and their family members. This special kind of training seeks to increase their livelihoods. These different trainings are organized across different issues and agendas which include Self Help Group, Micro Enterprise, Education, Fish Sanitation and Drying System etc.



## **D HEALTH CAMPS :**





The health camps are organized to ensure that fishermen and their family members are not deprived from basic health care facilities due to lack of basic medical facilities at the port of Tragadi. During this health camp, free medical treatment is provided to the family members of the local fishermen staying at the port of Tragadi by conducting a preliminary examination if any disease or illness is detected. Under the Sagarbandh program six different types of health camps were organized which addressed different health problems of fisher community at Tragadi Bandar.

## **E GOVERNMENT SCHEMES-AWARENESS & COLLABORATIONS :**

A Government Scheme Awareness Camp was organized to provide information about the benefits of the Government Scheme and the processes of acquiring its benefits. Under this awareness camp, fishermen were provided detailed information about government benefits for fishermen such as solar boat latch, solar light, GPS machine and ice box etc.

## **F CULTURAL PROGRAMS :**

Cultural programs are organized for fishermen and their families living on Tragadi Bunder. The purpose of this cultural program is to connect with the community and raise awareness on various social issues in the community. A large number of fishermen and their family members participate in this cultural program.



## **SAGAR SHALA :**

There are various activities undertaken with special focus on the education of the children of the fishing families who lives on Tragadi Bunder. For this, the STP classes from standard 1 to standard 8 are run by the government under special educational program and the infrastructures and facilities are provided by CGPL and Swadeep Shikshan Vikas Sanstha. We call it Sagar Shala.

### **Water Wheel Distribution :**

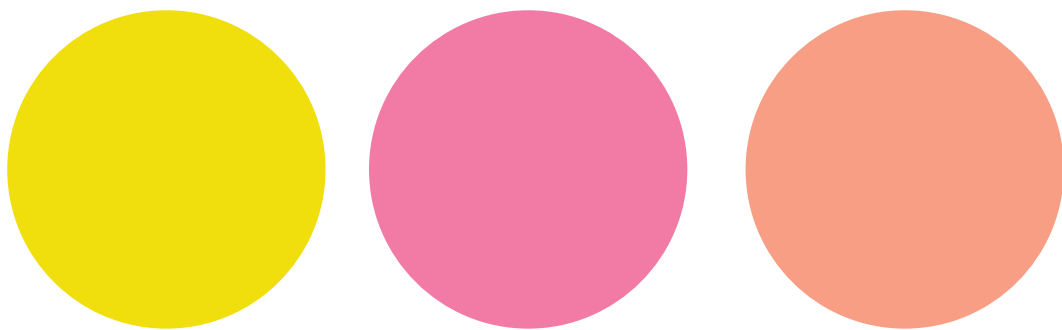
Many of these fishermen families walk quite a long distance to collect water from collection point. Therefore CGPL has arrange the distribution program along with Corbett Foundation and provided The water-wheel. It is well designed water drum, having the capacity to carry 45 liters of water which is very easy to roll it, even if fully filled with water. These will help women to carry 45 liters of water in a single run.



### **Solar Dryer :**

Solar fish dryer were installed at Modhva, Tragadi and Tragadi Bunder for demonstration and promotion of use solar energy purpose. Solar fish dryer is very useful for the local fishermen to make fish dry without compromising the quality of the fish. This solar fish dryer has been installed in the villages. So that other fishermen of the village may know about it and they also get to know about how this solar dryer works.

# 1. Capacity Building on Health, Hygiene & Education



## INTRODUCTION :

Health of Children in the villages is often compromised. The causative factor is understood to be the hygiene levels that they maintain. These are the reason of them inviting diseases and the net result is stunning of children. India has about 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the child population that is stunned and is also seen as the causative reason for high under five mortality rates. It is 'Swachhta' or Cleanliness which it is worked upon will help in reducing the incidences of gastro intestinal diseases and diseases like Jaundice, Typhoid and Cholera. Initially the Project seeks to work on the issue of swachhta in the village Saily of Dadra and Nagar Haveli which latter on even included the education program with government schools.

**Project Area:** **Silvassa, Dadra Nagar Haveli (U/T)**

## PROJECT AREA :

The Project is currently being implemented in Saily Village which is located at the distance of 7kms from Silvassa, the H.Q of the administration of the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli. The village had a population of 15, 655 in 2011 and had about 3,801 Households. Project covers all 14 ICDS Centers of village and 6 Primary schools as well.

## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :

### **A DISTRIBUTION OF PERSONAL HYGIENE KIT-SCHOOL:**

A personal hygiene kit was distributed to the students coming to the school under "Capacity Building on health, hygiene and education". Promoting good personal hygiene habits does more than protect children from the threat of germs and disease. It also helps keep them looking and smelling clean and fresh, and promotes their general health. This personal hygiene kit was distributed to a total of 789 school children from 6 primary schools.



### **B CLEANLINESS & SANITATION KIT DISTRIBUTION :**

Maintaining cleanliness in Anganwadi and school is very important. Regular hygiene is especially important for the health of children. Materials and equipment required for cleaning have been provided regularly under this project especially for the health of the children coming in school and Anganwadi. All 14 Anganwadis and 6 primary schools have also regularly refilled this cleanliness kit.

### **C CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOP FOR ANGANWADI WORKERS & HELPERS :**

Under this project, special attention has been paid to capacity building of Anganwadi workers and Helpers. Thus a total of 4 workshops were organized during the tenure of the project. In which Anganwadi workers have been trained on various activities and topic to deliver effective pre-primary education. Specialists have been called for these trainings. The main theme of training in these workshops include puppet making, art of storytelling, teaching creative crafts with local resources and activities with music etc.





### **D DISTRIBUTION OF MOTIVATIONAL KIT :**

A special motivation kit was distributed by Balmer Lawrie to commemorate their dedication to their Anganwadi children. Special attention was paid to the needs and use of Anganwadi worker and helper women in their day to day life in these motivational gifts. Gifts like water bottles, jute bugs and crockery sets are given to them. Anganwadi workers and helpers women are very proud to have received this motivational kit.



### **E ANGANWADI PARENTS MEETING :**

Under this project, Swadeep has made a successful effort to raise awareness among the parents of children coming to Anganwadi about pre-primary education. 2 rounds of meetings have been held with the parents of the children coming in 14 Anganwadis during the tenure of the project. In these meetings, parents were given information on various topics such as the need for hygiene, health of children, hand washing techniques, nutritious food for children, save the environment, stop using plastic, save water, regular vaccination of children and various activities done in Anganwadi etc.





## **F DISTRIBUTION OF TEACHING LEARNING MATERIALS :**

Children come to Anganwadi to learn and enjoy various activities. In every Anganwadi, Anganwadi worker conducts various activities with children. And to add with their activities- Teaching Learning Materials, Play equipment, Board Games, Puzzles, Workbook, Drawing books for Anganwadi children are provided respectively. With the help of these tools and teaching materials, it can be very helpful in mental, physical and intellectual development of Anganwadi children. And most of all, the children enjoy doing activities with these materials.

## **G ANGANWADI ACTIVITIES :**

Every activity done in Anganwadi is very useful in the holistic development of children such as mental, physical, emotional and social development. Teams of educators from Swadeep have developed weekly and monthly plans for Anganwadi activities as part of school readiness preparation. In this plan, various activities are organized for the children of different age groups coming to the Anganwadi. Under the project, more than **600** children are covered in activities related to pre-primary education.





## **LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE-PRIMARY SCHOOL :**



LRC Classes are started for children with learning deficit in subjects like Maths and Gujarati for standard 3 to 8. Such students are selected from baseline test and special attention is given to them in LRC Class. Remedial teaching is done through activity base learning which helps these children with grade appropriate competence. With the help of TLMs, students can easily explain the subject of mathematics and they also enjoy doing those activities. Similarly for Gujarati subject also play cards, story charts and other useful educational materials are given to the students. In addition, a specially prepared workbook for LRC class students has also been distributed. A total **70** students are covered in LRC class.





## **I SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (SMC) MEETINGS:**

During this project, regular meetings have been organized with the school management committee in 6 primary schools and information about the activities and programs of the project has been given. During this meeting, we've discussed the various topics such as educational progress, attendance of students and their regularity in schools etc. In addition, special attention has been paid to cleanliness and sanitation awareness in the schools.

## **J PARENTS MEETING WITH LRC STUDENTS :**

Meetings were held with the parents of LRC class students running in the two primary schools. The main purpose of the meeting with the parents of the students was to provide information about the classes run by Balmer Lawrie and the activities carried out in these classes.

## **K WALL PAINTING FOR AWARENESS :**

Wall painting has been done to increase the awareness of every member of the community about the social awareness campaign run by the government. These wall paintings are based on the government-run sanitation campaign, education campaign, ban on plastic consumption, etc. These wall paintings are done at various places in Silvassa so the message of this social awareness reaches maximum community members.

## 2. Swachhata Pakhwada



### INTRODUCTION :

SwacchtaPakhwada is a fortnight initiative to carry on the agenda of Swachh Bharat Mission, aimed at promoting cleanliness. Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan is an initiative started by government of India to make the country completely clean of any mess or littering, thereby making every nook and corner of the nation clean and tidy. The Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd has taken initiatives to celebrate "SwachhatPakhwada "at Khadoli village, Silvassa. The objectives of this celebration were to spread the awareness on Swachhata to partake in Swachh Bharat Mission. This program was organized to celebrate from 1st July 2019 to 15th July -2019.

## ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT :

### **A PROGRAM INAUGURATION:**

The Swachhata Pakhwada programme was inaugurated on 1<sup>st</sup> July-2019 in Khadoli village. The dignitaries of the Dias thrown light the importance of Swachhta in our day to day life and promote and part take in Swacch Bharat Mission to make our nation clean and healthy. Mass Pledge on SwachhataPakhwada,was taken by all present guests.



### **B DEMONSTRATION ACTIVITIES ON SANITATION & HYGIENE:**

Children personal hygiene needs change dramatically during this early childhood stage. One of the most important self-hygiene tasks that preschool-aged and primary school aged children need to master is hand washing. In addition to frequent hand washing, children need to learn other ways to prevent the spread of germs. To address awareness on personal hygiene a kit distribution programs was organised at 4 primary schools of Khadoligrampanchayat.





## **C DRAWING COMPETITION AT PRIMARY SCHOOL:**

Primary schools level competitions are about more than just participation and winning prizes, they can play a major role in uncovering and nurturing natural talents of the students. In order to promote Swacch Bharat Abhiyan we organized the drawing competition at all Khadoli Grampanchayat's primary schools. The drawing competition theme was "Swachta".



## **D CLEANLINESS DRIVE SCHOOLS :**

School is a place where one can learn so many things. Every day the students spend a lot of time in school for learning and playing. Children in the school can be encouraged to put waste in appropriate bins so that they develop a habit of disposing of waste properly. Cleanliness, Personal hygiene, Good sanitation provides a clean school environment for the students to keep them in good health and safe. In Cleanliness Drive at school activities, we have tried to spread awareness on Cleanliness and provide the suggestion on maintaining cleanliness.

We have covered the topics such as how to teach various teaching methods for Anganwadi children, what are the various stages of child development including emotional stage; social stage and physical stage, how important are abhinaygeet and baalgeet for Anganwadi children, creative crafts and arts activity with children etc.





## **PLAY MATERIALS FOR ICDS CHILDREN:**

Most of the Anganwadi do not have sufficient teaching learning materials for early childhood care and education and the Anganwadi Worker have not received any special training regarding preparation and use of teaching learning materials effectively for making the learning environment more easy and joyful. With the help of financial partner, Swadeep distributed TLMs and play equipments at all Anganwadi. We have also explained the instruction about how to use these TLMs to Anganwadi Worker.





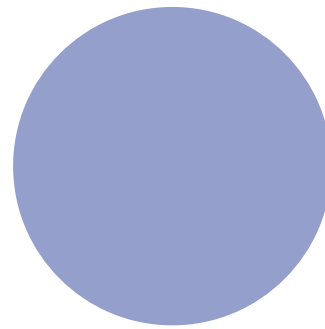
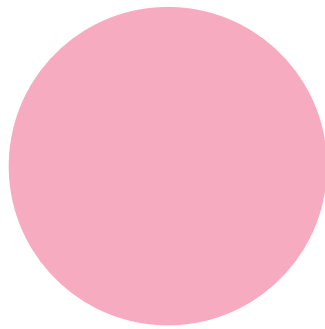
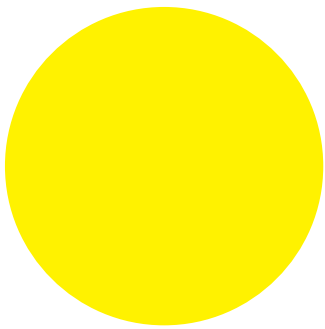
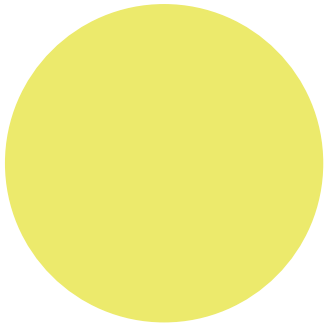
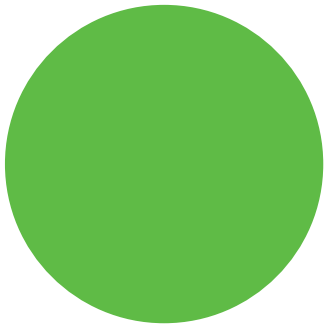
## **D ICDS BEAUTIFICATION :**

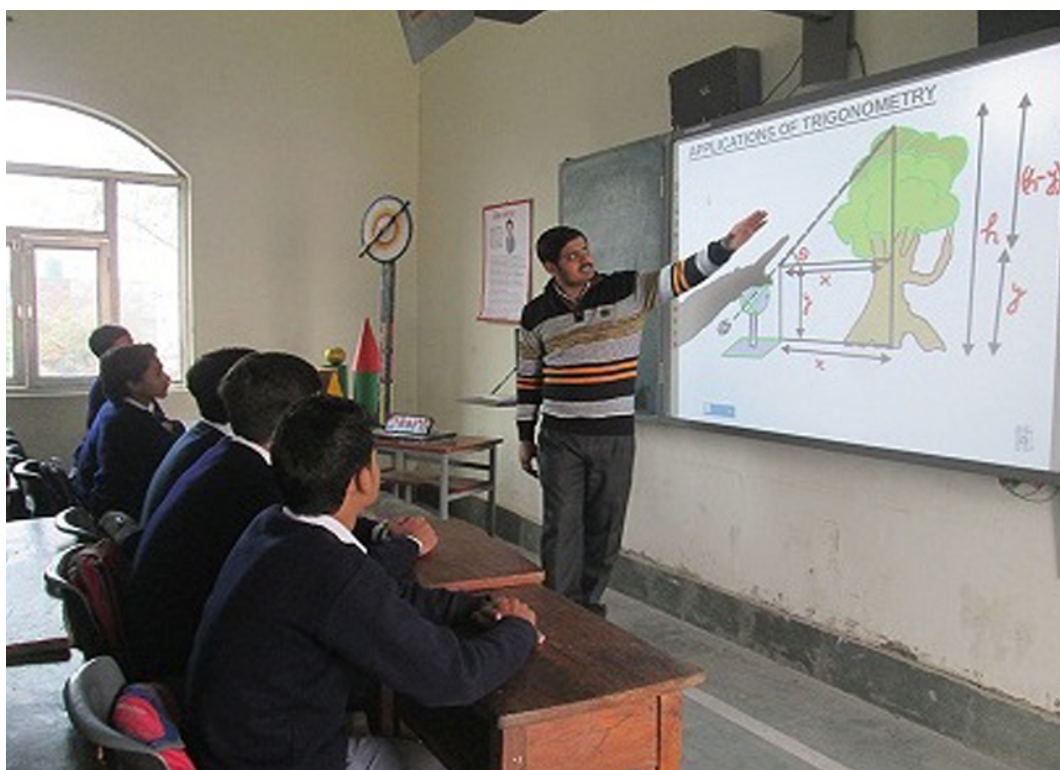
# 4. Smart Class Installation Project

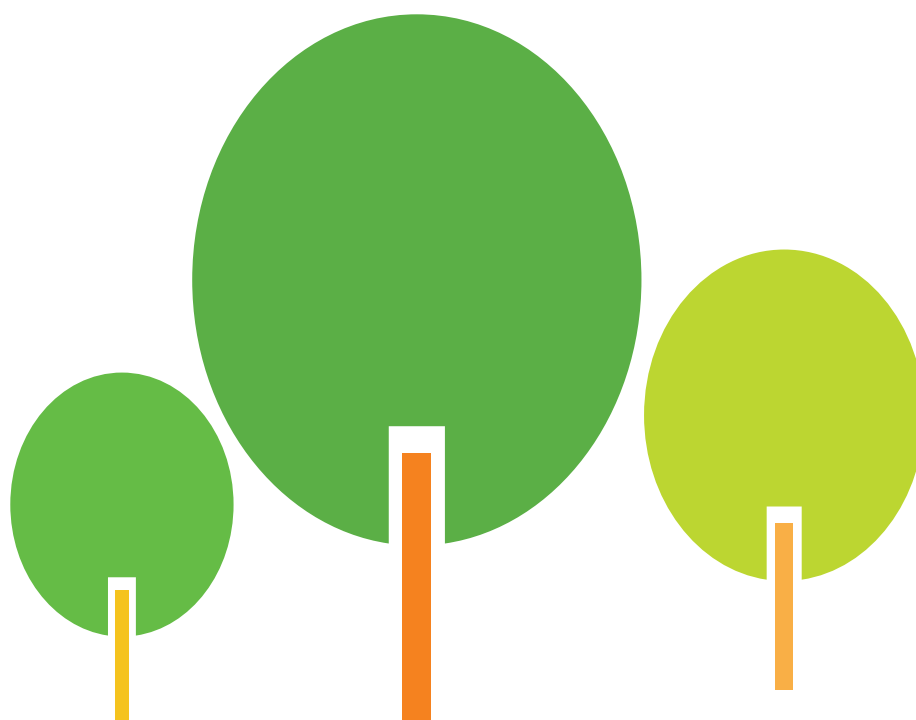
# 5. Tree Plantation Project
